Sam, Marsha,

Yesterday I called Kurt Jaeger the former owner of ██████ Donnington Ct, Simi Valley CA 93065. His property is within the Sycamore Canyon Village HOA. He planted a large (many hundreds of trees covering many acres of land) commercial Avocado orchard in around 2003 on this property. He said he is sure he did not submit any application for approval (or anything like that) for the planting of the Avocado trees with the SCV HOA.

The only other farm/ranch lot in the SCV besides ours is the Doherty's and they have not planted any fruit trees other than a few around their house. I know this because we can see their entire property from the top of our hill and what they told me.

In summary we are the only party to be issued a Stop Work Order for Agricultural activity and only for one of the many agricultural activities we have undertaken.
